(2) Published in two parts

Continuing from last year, this year's report comprises two parts: *Corporate Responsibility Communication 2015* and *CSR Case Report*. The former provides an overview of our corporate responsibility initiatives, a description of group CSR-KPIs, and examples of specific initiatives for each material issue. The latter provides a more thorough account of specific initiatives.

(3) Enhanced accessibility to desired content

This fiscal year we enhanced accessibility by providing links for jumping from the index to the desired section of the report. Content is also linked to our official website so stakeholders can obtain the latest information at any time.
